The Mitzvot in Parashat Yitro

P1 To believe in God. Exodus 20:2

N1 Not to believe in any other deity. Exodus 20:3

N2 Not to make any image for the purpose of worship in the likeness of anything. Exodus 20:4

N5 Not to prostrate oneself before an idol. Exodus 20:5

N6 Not to worship an idol in its customary mode of worship. Exodus 20:5

N62 Not to swear an oath in God's name purposelessly or under false pretenses. Exodus 20:7

P155 To verbally declare the Sabbath holy. Exodus 20:8

N320 Not to work on the Sabbath. Exodus 20:10

P210 To honor one's father and mother. Exodus 20:8

N289 Not to take the life of an innocent person, which constitutes murder. Exodus 20:13

N347 Not to be conjugally intimate with another's spouse. Exodus 20:13(14)

N243 Not to steal (kidnap) another person. Exodus 20:13(15)

N285 Not to give a false testimony or talk vainly about others. Exodus 20:13(16)

N265 Not to scheme to acquire what belongs to another person; to not covet anything which belongs to another. Exodus 20:1:4(17)

N4 Not to make any sculptured human images, even if only for the purpose of decoration. Exodus 20:20(23)

N79 Not to build an altar to God out of hewn stones, i.e., stones which have come into any contact with iron. Exodus 20:22(25)

N80 Priest not to ascend to the altar of the Tabernacle/Temple by stairs and/or long strides. Exodus 20:26
