Common English Name	Hebrew Name	Scripture
Burnt Offering	<i>Olah</i> (עולה)	Leviticus 1:1–17, 6:1–6(8–13)
Grain Offering	<i>Minchah</i> (מנחה)	Leviticus 2:1–16, 6:7–16(14–23)
Peace Offerings	<i>Shelamim</i> (שלמים)	Leviticus 3:1–17, 7:11–36
Sin Offering	<i>Chattat</i> (חטאת)	Leviticus 4:1–5:13, 6:17–24(24–30)
Guilt Offering	<i>Asham</i> (אשם)	Leviticus 5:1–26(6:7), 7:1–10

The Mitzvah List for Parashat Vayikra

To offer the burnt offering according to its specifications. Leviticus 1:2

To offer the grain offering according to its specifications. Leviticus 2:1

Not to offer leaven (chametz) or honey on the altar. Leviticus 2:11

Not to offer a sacrifice without salt. Leviticus 2:13

To salt every sacrifice. Leviticus 2:13

To offer the sin offering of a court that has erred. Leviticus 4:13

To offer the sin offering of an individual. Leviticus 4:27

To testify in court. Leviticus 5:1

To offer the variable offering. Leviticus 5:1-11

Not to sever the head of a bird brought as a sin [or guilt] offering. Leviticus 5:8

Not to put olive oil in a grain offering for sin. Leviticus 5:11

Not to offer frankincense with a grain offering for sin. Leviticus 5:11

To offer the fixed guilt offering. Leviticus 5:15

To offer a guilt offering of uncertainty for doubtful guilt. Leviticus 5:17

To pay restitution for the sacrilege of misusing the holy things. Leviticus 5:16

To restore the stolen article. Leviticus 5:23(6:4)
